There are only 19 comments to be resolved, too few to justify the expense of a face-to-face meeting. The editing will be done by e-mail between the members of the editing committee (EC).

The editing management committee has appointed Mr. Antony Cooper as chair and Dr. Robert Maher as editor of the editing committee. Each convenor may appoint members from their WG to the editing committee to ensure harmonization with the different ISO/TC 211 standards.

P-members and liaison members may appoint **one** member to the editing committee, preferably one that has been actively working in the project team. The chairman of the editing committee may ask other members of the project team to participate where he finds this appropriate.

Members who want to have a representative in the editing process are kindly asked to notify the secretariat (bjs@nts.no) as soon as possible, and **no later than 2003-03-21**.

The document to be edited is N 1319. Each appointed member of the EC will receive the comments (document N 1379, also available via the document register) in a sorted version, and the list of the members of the EC.

- Each EC member must be easily available by e-mail during the 2 weeks discussion period.
- The EC chair is in charge of coordinating the e-mail discussions within the EC.
- The editor is in charge of completing the table with the decisions of the EC. The final table with the decisions of the EC shall be distributed to the EC for approval.
- After the EC e-mail discussion period, the editor shall update the draft (N 1319). The updated draft shall be distributed to the EC for approval before it is sent to the secretariat.
- The secretariat will submit the final draft to ISO for publishing as a Technical Report.
