# **Working group meeting on Project 19122 Geographic Information / Geomatics - Qualifications and certification of personnel March 7-8th**

Project 19122 differs from the other Working Groups, with its emphasis on human resources. The context of qualifications and certification has important implications for the international professional associations and within individual countries. At the country level, there are likely different perspectives from industry, academia and the government agencies.

The objectives of the workshop will be:

- 1) to examine the assumptions and definitions expressed in the background paper;
- 2) to identify additional resources and points of view, not expressed hitherto;
- 3) to reach agreement, where possible, on the key issues;
- 4) to develop a work plan with specific tasks for the next six month period.
