# PT 19123 Coverage Geometry and Functions

- Held its 4<sup>th</sup> meeting here in Reston
- Reviewed the 4<sup>th</sup> Working Draft
- Resolved remaining issues before submission as a Committee Draft
- Aim for CD beginning of November 2000



# CD 19107.3 Spatial Schema

- 420 comments
- 4 no votes – Finland, Germany, Sweden and Switzerland
- 288 comments accepted or accepted in principle
- 70 comments not accepted
- 62 comments pending
- The critical Finnish, German and Swedish comments were accepted



# CD 19107.3 Spatial Schema

- Joint effort with 19118 Encoding needed to resolve comments
- This EC decided not to override the previous EC to accept the majority of the Swiss comments
- The editors will provide more detailed reasons for not accepting these comments



# CD 19107.3 Spatial Schema

- Aim for DIS in January 2001
- Need graphical examples of some implementations of 19107 and of geometrical and topological concepts
- Need NWIPs for creation of application schemas for particular communities, based on the spatial schema – eg: cadastre



# DIS 19108 Temporal Schema

- All comments have been resolved
- Pending discussion at the Plenary, this will go to DIS immediately



# CD 19109.2 Rules for Application Schema

- 490 comments; 210 technical, but many “editorials” are actually technical
- Accepted ~80% of comments
- No radical restructuring but some significant changes: will revise rules for quality (MHT) & spatial attributes (19107); eliminate quality for data sets; streamline vocabulary; complete documentation of GFM
- Plan 3<sup>rd</sup> CD for ballot mid-November 2000
- Next EC meeting in Lisbon
